2021 Prospect Vale Women's Open Tournament

Notes & Conditions

1. The Championship

The Championships will be played over 18 holes stroke/stableford play on Thursday 18th November 2021 and is open to all registered Women golfers with an official Australian handicap as at the closing date for entries of the tournament.

2. Championship Committee

The Championship Committee consists of the PVGC Match Committee. In the absence of the full Match Committee such members thereof as may be present at any time may give a decision and any such decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Championship Committee.

3. Rules

3.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited will apply together with such local rules as are provided by the PVGC Match Committee.

3.2 The decision of the PVGC Match Committee will be final in all matters relating to the tournament. Protests must be made to the Committee not later than five minutes after the conclusion of the day's play.

3.3 The PVGC Match Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without explanation and to vary any condition of this event.

3.4 In the event of a player failing to hand in a card and satisfactorily explaining the omission to the PVGC Match Committee, she shall be disqualified from all events in the 2021 PVGC Open Tournament.

4. Entries

4.1 Must be made on the official form and must be accompanied by the Entry Fee. Forms must be received by the closing date of 12th November 2021.

4.2 All handicaps will be fixed by the PVGC Match Committee. The player's handicap shall be her Australian Golf Link handicap as at Thursday 18th November 2021.

5. Competitors

The field will be limited to approximately 100 players. Should the field exceed this number the higher handicap players will be balloted out and their entry fee will be refunded. All references to handicap will be taken as at time of entry.

6. Measuring Device

Artificial measuring devices that measure or gauge distance only will be permitted to be used under, Rule 14-3 *Equipment*

7. Draw and Starting Times

7.1 A draw for the day's play will be emailed to those who supply their email address.

Players shall start at the time and in the order arranged by the Committee. Rule 6-3a provides "the player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee." The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However, it is a condition of this Championship that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification provided by Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes of this starting time the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes instead of disqualification.

7.2 In the event of bad weather or for any other reason the PVGC Match Committee may either shorten the tournament or appoint an alternative date and/or venue for completion of the Open Tournament.

8. Ties

8.1 In the event of a tie or ties for the Tournament, unless the PVGC Match Committee otherwise determines, play shall continue over such holes as the PVGC Match Committee shall decide, players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with other or others until the winner is determined.

8.2 Ties in handicap events will be decided by count back in accordance with the system approved by Golf Australia.

Golf Australia "Code of Conduct" will be in force for the 2021 PVGC Open Tournament
