GTN Executive:

My thanks to the Executive members of Golf Tasmania North for their valued and tireless work for the members Clubs in the Northern District.

The Executive of Golf Tasmania North elected in 2012 to run golf in the Northern District were Don Cameron (President), Mrs Frances Hudson (Vice President), Peter Ashdown, Tony Bush, Gavan Griffin, Curt Mathews, Sheryl Manion, Greg Williams with Mr Robert Fitzgerald as Secretary. I thank each and everyone for their dedication to the golfers of the Northern District, in particular Frances Hudson, Sheryl Manion and Rob Fitzgerald for the smooth running of all women's events. Tony Bush and the Junior Committee, I particularly want to thank Rob Fitzgerald as Secretary for his prompt and efficient running of all business in the Northern District for all Men, Women & Juniors.

Our great thanks to Frances Hudson, Sheryl Manion, Elaine Rigby, Trevor Atkinson, Rod Eiszele and Rob Fitzgerald for the continued support in starting the fields and/or marking cards whenever we have run a major event for Golf Tasmania North.

Financial and Secretary Report:

Following my appointment as Secretary to Golf Tasmania North in August 2012, the GTN Committee expanded the secretarial responsibilities to include the Northern Tasmanian Junior Golf Development Committee. The NTJGD Committee had always been a sub-committee of GTN but previously had controlled its own finances and was not subject to audit. The GTN Committee decided that proper governance required greater accountability and so decided to bring all NTJGD accounting records under the banner of GTN and consequently the appearance of this 2012/13 end of year accounts will vary slightly from last year.

GTN has finished the year with a small loss of \$324.00 while the NTJGD traded profitably finishing the year with a profit of \$1,011.00. The financial accounts show the result as an overall a profit of \$687.00 for the organization.

At 30th June 2013 both Committees were in a sound financial position with GTN holding cash reserves of \$ 80,357.00 and the NTJGD holding cash reserves of \$ 5,867.00.

My time as GTN secretary has been brief but the support provided to me by the GTN Committee, in particular Don Cameron, Frances Hudson and Curt Mathews and the co-operation from the various officials from each of the member clubs, has made the experience very rewarding. I would like to thank everyone for their efforts in trying to ensure that golf in our Northern region is run on a professional basis and while many of our men's major tournaments have struggled for numbers, it is pleasing the see the women's events have been well supported, particularly the ladies City Week and the Ladies Country Week events that were booked out within days of the entry forms being released.

In February, the NTJGD raised \$4280.00 at their annual golf day fundraiser which will ensure the continuation of professional development programs and one on one coaching for those promising young golfers in our district who are committed to improving their skills.

During the year I have tried to build on the information available on our website. Pennant scores were uploaded within 24 hours of the completion of events and the feedback indicates this has been well received by all pennant players.

Your new Secretary for the 2013/14 year is Curt Mathews from the Mowbray Golf Club. Curt is a very keen golfer and has a finance and administration background. He has served on the GTN Committee so he comes to the position with the ideal qualifications for the role. I wish him every success as your new Secretary.

This change satisfies both efficiency and independence. A decision was also taken during the year to ask non attending committee members, parents of past juniors, to indicate their interest in continuing on the committee. This was done to make sure we are relevant to current juniors and hopefully attracting their parents to assist us.

Achievements of our juniors in 2012/13:

The 2012 winner of The Betty Bradley Consistency Trophy was Prospect Vale's Kiren Jarman. This award is made to the player with the best averages over the school holiday tournaments.

This year's GTN's Claremont Shield team was made up of Isaac Pinnington, Dougie Warren, Alex House and Zac Swan. This team will in future be selected on performance in the GT Athol Shepherd consistency events.

The Committee assisted with funding for Kade Philpott, Isaac Pinnington, Jack Tregaskisjago and Dougie Warren to attend the 2012 Aaron Baddeley International Junior Australian final at the Heritage Golf Club in the Yarra Valley. Thanks to Dean Pinnington who acted as chaperone for the boys.

Prospect Vale's Jack Tregaskisjago won the North West Junior Championship played at Seabrook with rounds of 78 and 80. Riverside's Sam Rawlings won his first ever colts championship with 79 and 74.

Mowbray's Joel Harwood and George Waller and Launceston's Alex House representing Scotch Oakburn College won the Tasmanian Division of the 2012 Australian Secondary School Teams Championship at Mowbray. They played in the National Final at the Peninsula Golf Club.

1 Accounting Policies

These financial statements are a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the accounts preparation requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (Tasmania) 1964.

The committee have determined that the Golf Tasmania North Incorporated is not a reporting entity and therefore there is no need to apply Australian Accounting Standards or other mandatory professional reporting requirements in the preparation and presentation of the financial statements.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historical costs modified by the revaluation of selected non-current assets, financial assets and financial liabilities for which the fair value basis of accounting has been applied.

Following the change of name, and amalgamation with Womens Golf Tasmania - North, Golf Tasmania North Incorporated altered its financial year to 30 June from 31 December. Accordingly, comparatives are for the financial statements are for the 18 month period ended 30 June 2012.

The following specific accounting policies, which are consistent with previous periods unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report:

(a) Property, Plant and Equipment

Each class of property, plant and equipment is carried at cost or fair value less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation and impairment losses. Depreciation is provided on a reducing balance basis to write off each individual asset over its estimated useful life.

(b) Revenue

Tournment income and club capitation revenue is reconised when the entity obtains control over the funds, which is generally at the time of receipt.

Interest revenue is recognised using the effective interest method, which for floating rate financial assets is the rate inherent in the instrument.



Report on the Financial Report

We have audited the accompanying financial report, being a special purpose financial report, of Golf Tasmania North Incorporated, which comprises the balance sheet as at 30 June 2013, the income statement for the year then ended, a summary of significant accounting policies, other explanatory notes and the treasurer's declaration.

The Committee's Responsibility for the Financial Report

The committee of Golf Tasmania North Incorporated are responsible for the preparation of the financial report and have determined that the basis of preparation described in Note 1 to the financial report is appropriate to meet the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (Tasmania) 1964 and is appropriate to meet the needs of the members.

The committee's responsibility also includes such internal control as the committee determine is necessary to enable the preparation of a financial report that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the financial report based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards. Those standards require that we comply with relevant ethical requirements relating to audit engagements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial report is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial report. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgement, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial report, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation of the financial report that gives a true and fair view in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the committee, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial report.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

Independence

In conducting our audit, we have complied with the independence requirements of the Australian professional accounting bodies and any legislative requirements.

Basis for Qualified Auditor's Opinion

Tournament income and NTJGD income are significant sources of revenue for Golf Tasmania North Incorporated. The committee has determined that it is impracticable to establish control over the collection of this revenue prior to entry into its financial records. Accordingly, as the evidence available to us regarding revenue from this source was limited, our audit procedures with respect to tournament income, NTJGD income and other uncontrollable income items was restricted to the amounts recorded in the financial records. We therefore are unable to express an opinion as to the completeness of the club's revenue.

Qualified Auditor's Opinion

In our opinion, except for the effects of such adjustments, if any, as might have been determined to be necessary had we been able to satisfy ourselves as to the completeness of revenue:

- the financial report presents fairly, in accordance with the accounting policies described in Note 1 to the financial statements, the financial position of Golf Tasmania North Incorporated at 30 June 2013, and of its performance for the year then ended;
- we obtained the information we required for the audit and Golf Tasmania North Incorporated kept proper accounting records and other books during the year ended 30 June 2013; and
- the rules relating to the administration of the funds of Golf Tasmania North Incorporated have been observed.

Basis of Accounting

Without modifying our opinion, we draw attention to Note 1 to the financial report, which describes the basis of accounting. The financial report is a special purpose financial report that has been prepared for the purpose of fulfilling the committee's financial reporting responsibilities under the Associations Incorporation Act (Tasmania) 1964. As a result, the financial report may not be suitable for another purpose.
